


The Creed

FAITH is **truths** revealed by God, who cannot deceive himself or deceive us. He has told us them so that we have security in what we believe.



I believe in one God:


There is only one God.


Almighty Father:

He makes everything out of nothing.


He is the beginning and end of all things.
