





What are the sacraments?

Visible signs that indicate to us that there is an invisible reality.

The sign can be in many ways: image, gesture, word, object.



INVISIBLE REALITY



- According to the Catechism, the sacraments are:
 - Sensitive and effective signs of grace.
 - Instituted by Christ.
 - Entrusted to the Church.
 - Through which divine life is granted to us.

The word grace here means the gift or favor that is received from God freely, without any personal merit.



- Sensitive and effective signs of grace. It is a sign that I can notice with my senses.
 - water cleanses... baptism cleanses the soul
- <u>Instituted by Christ</u>. He invented them.
 They appear in the New Testament.
- Entrusted to the Church. The Church is the only one who can administer them, say how they are done, ...
- Through whom divine life is granted to <u>us</u>. It is through them that God's grace reaches us in the main way.

The seven sacraments

- Baptism
- Confirmation
- Eucharist
- Penance
- Anointing of the Sick
- Priestly order
- Marriage



Sacraments of initiation

Baptism:

- Door that opens the way to other sacraments
- It incorporates us into the Church

Confirmation:

- Receiving the power of the Spirit
- The fullness of baptismal grace is reached

Eucharist:

- The initiation culminates
- Participation food eternal life (Bread and Wine)

Healing Sacraments


- Penance:
 - Forgive us the sins we have committed.

- Anointing of the Sick:
 - The Church prays for our healing
 - helps him die well.

Sacraments service

- Priestly Order:
 - The priest is about to administer the sacraments.

- Marriage:
 - The union of man and woman is so important that God gives them a specific grace to help them bring about the family,





BAPTISM:

ACTION:

Immerse the person being baptized in water.



BAPTISM:

EFFECT:

- ◆ Forgive Original Sin and all sins.
- ◆ It makes us children of God.
- ◆ It makes us members of the Catholic Church.
- ◆ Indelible mark.



BAPTISM:

FORMULA:

I baptize you in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.


Minister: The priest or baptized person.






THE CONFIRMATION

Laying on of hands

Anointing with chrism

EFFECTS:



- The effect is the full outpouring of the Holy Spirit, as was granted to the apostles on the day of Pentecost.
- It involves growth and deepening of baptismal grace.
- It introduces us more into divine filiation.
- It unites us more to Christ.
- Increase the "gifts of the Holy Spirit."
- Grant a special strength to spread the faith through words and deeds.

Formula



- Renewal of baptismal promises
- Invocation to the Holy Spirit
- Laying on of hands
- Chrismation (Anointing with chrism)
- The greeting of peace
- Only the Bishop can confirm.

EUCHARIST:

ACTION:

Eating the Body of Jesus, usually at Mass.

We can also ask for it if we are sick.



EUCHARIST

- **EFFECTS:**
- ◆ Communion in divine life and the unity of the People of God.
- ◆ We anticipate eternal life.
- ◆ CONDITIONS:
- ◆ To be in God's grace.
- ◆ 1 hour before without eating.
- ◆ Know what you are doing.




EUCHARIST

FORMULA:

The Body of Christ. Amen. We eat in our mouths or by hand.

Minister: The priest or authorized person.



Sunday mass is more than an obligation.

It is the most important moment in our relationship with God and with our brothers.



The Tabernacle: living heart of our temples

- The Church guards it with special veneration.
- It reaches the sick.
- ◆ That is why there is the custom of praying before the tabernacle: the visit and adoration before the Blessed Sacrament.





THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE

PENITENCE:



ACTION:

- **Examination of conscience.**
- ◆Pain of sins.
- ◆Purpose of amendment.
- ◆Tell your sins to the confessor.
- Fulfill the penance.



PENITENCE:

EFFECT:

- He forgives us all the sins committed since the last good confession.
- ◆ Sacramental grace increases us.

PENITENCE

FORMULA:

Tell your sins to the confessor.
I absolve you of your sins in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Minister: Only the priest





THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK



THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

ACTION:

The sign of the cross is made on the forehead and on each of the sick person's hands.



THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

EFFECT:


- ◆ Forgive the sins of the sick person if he cannot confess them.
- ◆ It gives us strength to die well.
- ♦ It can cure our illness.

THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

FORMULA:

By this Holy anointing and by his kind mercy, may the Lord help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. So that, free from your sins, he may grant you salvation and comfort you in your illness. Amen.

Minister: Only the priest





THE PRIESTLY ORDER



THE ORDER PRIESTLY

ACTION:

At Mass, the bishop lays his hands on the head and anoints the breasts with sacramental oil.



THE PRIESTLY ORDER

EFFECT:

- ◆ Indelible mark.
- ◆ It gives him power to be the mediator between God and men.
- + He represents Jesus. When he acts, he is Jesus himself.



THE PRIESTLY ORDER

The mission of the priest consists of proclaiming the Gospel, administering the sacraments, guiding the Christian community and serving those in need.




THE ORDER PRIESTLY

FORMULA:

May he receive the Priesthood from You and may his life be a good example for others.

Minister: Only the bishop





MARRIAGE



THE MARRIAGE:

ACTION:

Commitment

- ◆Help each other.
- + Having children and educating them.
- ◆Until the end of our lives.



THE MARRIAGE:

EFFECT:

- Give them the grace to be good parents,
- ◆Good husbands.
- ◆ Be faithful to the commitment.



THE MARRIAGE:

FORMULA:

At Mass, the newlyweds declare that they want to get married.

Ministers: The bride and groom. The priest is a witness of the Church.
