Dogma of faith: truths that we must believe because they cannot be proven and have been revealed by God in the scriptures.

The dogma is defined by the Holy Father in Rome. It is what he says is the truth.

Dogmas that refer to the Virgin Mary:

1. Divine Motherhood of Mary (Council of Ephesus, year 431) Mary is the Mother of God (Theotokos), because her Son, Jesus Christ, is truly God and truly man.

2. Perpetual Virgin. Mary conceived Jesus virginally, and remained a virgin before, during and after childbirth.

3. Immaculate Conception (proclaimed by Pius IX in 1854) Mary was conceived without original sin, preserved by God in anticipation of the merits of Christ.

4. Assumption of Mary (proclaimed by Pius XII in 1950) Mary, at the end of the Her earthly life was assumed body and soul into heaven.
